

# TGH MONOCLONAL ANTIBODY PROTOCOL

Dr. Cancio, Infectious Disease, and FPA Board Member, asked us to share this information with you.

TGH is offering monoclonal antibodies to Covid positive patients before they get too sick. The purpose is to prevent admission to the hospital. Below is the protocol.

To refer patients over to Tampa General Hospital for the EUA Monoclonal Antibody Infusions:

- Patients should be evaluated by primary care provider and deemed eligible for the MAB infusion based off listed criteria below and ensure they do NOT need hospitalization.

  - Full patient name
  - DOB
  - Social security number
  - Gender
  - Address
  - COVID-19 test result (preferably copy of result)
  - Provider stating they request for MAB infusion PLUS
    - Brief synopsis outlining the criteria the patient meets, including start date of symptoms
    - ONSET OF SYMPTOMS WITHIN 7 DAYS OF RECEIVING THE INFUSION.
    - If patient is immune compromised they have 10 days to be infused.
      - AGE > 18 yrs old: Diabetes, CKD, immunosuppressive disease or CURRENTLY receiving immunosuppressive medications, Obesity (BMI >35).
      - ANYONE 65 yrs and older
      - 55 yrs and older PLUS (at least 1): HTN or CAD or Asthma/COPD
- After faxing, send an email to [researchsupervisors@tgh.org](mailto:researchsupervisors@tgh.org) to alert us that a referral has been faxed over.
- Once the referral is received, we will create a patient account in our EMR and place the referral. The scheduling team will contact the patient, as soon as possible, to schedule the infusion.
